STALLION SERVICE CONTRACT

1. I _____, hereinafter referred to as the MARE OWNER, do hereby enter into an agreement with Cee Arr Appaloosa (Bill Cookshaw & Marie Rowe) hereinafter referred to as the STALLION OWNER, on this ____ day of _____, 2020 to breed the above named mare to the stallion **IMA DOCS HIGH SIGN**, ApHC registration #621229, during the 2020 breeding season. The 2020 breeding season shall be the period between March 1st, 2020 and June 30th 2020. The stud fee is \$750.00, which includes a \$150.00 non-refundable booking fee, which shall be payable upon the execution of this contract. The stud fee balance of \$600.00 will be due and payable in full, prior to the collection and processing of any semen. All fees are subject to 5% Goods & Services Tax (GST) for all Canadian residents. Cheques (checks), for payment of stud fee(s) shall be made payable to **Bill Cookshaw**, all money in CAD (Canadian) funds. Method of payments originating outside of Canada shall be by money order, bank draft, wire transfer or Pay Pal. Out of country personal cheques (checks) cannot be accepted due to Canadian bank processing issues.
2. In addition to the stud fee (and included booking fee) to the stallion owner, Moore Equine will require the mare owner to provide the number of a valid credit card. The mare owner agrees that the costs related to breeding the mare, including palpitations, ultra-sounds, daily mare care (board), vet, clinic and miscellaneous expense, will be charged by Moore Equine to the provided credit card as those expenses occur. The first and initial semen collection and processing fee will be paid by the STALLION OWNER. Any subsequent occurrences of semen collection and processing for breeding shall be paid for by the MARE OWNER at the reproduction clinic's current fee, plus gst when applicable.
3. It shall be understood by all parties that should the stallion die, or become unfit for service for any reason or if the mare should die or become unfit for breeding for any reason, that this contract shall become null and void and that both parties are relieved of any further obligation hereunder. If such circumstances do occur, the STALLION OWNER agrees to refund to the MARE OWNER any monies paid toward the stud fee, with the exception of the non-refundable booking fee. However, any and all incurred expenses relative to breeding the mare prior to that occurrence, shall be due and payable to Moore Equine.

4. This contract includes a "live foal guarantee". A live foal is described as a newborn foal that stands and nurses without assistance. If the foal dies without standing and nursing or is born dead, return breeding privileges shall apply only if the STALLION OWNER is notified promptly and receives a veterinarian's written statement confirming the foal's death. Return breeding privileges shall apply only to the next normal breeding period. All services provided by Moore Equine for return breedings will be charged at their applicable rate for the next breeding season.
5. The breeding facility agrees to make every effort to "settle" the Owner's mare, however if for any reason the mare does not "settle", the stallion Owner and/or Moore Equine shall not be held liable. The MARE OWNER hereby agrees to leave the mare at the breeding facility until she has been pregnancy checked and found to be in-foal. The MARE OWNER further agrees that if the mare does not "settle" in foal during the 2020 breeding season that the only recourse is a return breeding privilege during the 2021 breeding season. Should the MARE OWNER choose not to take advantage of the return breeding privilege prior to the end of the 2020 breeding season, then all return breeding privileges will be forfeited by the MARE OWNER. The 2021 breeding season will begin on March 1st and end at mid-night June 30th, 2021.
6. Moore Equine agrees to provide proper and adequate care including the administration of medical services as deemed necessary for the health and safety of the mare and, if applicable, any foal at side during their stay at the breeding facility. The MARE OWNER hereby authorizes any such care and attention and furthermore agrees to pay for any resulting expenses. It is hereby understood and agreed to, that Moore Equine and/or its members, agents or employees or the STALLION OWNER shall not be held liable for any accidental injury or death suffered by any horse while in the confines of the breeding facility. The undersigned MARE OWNER specifically agrees to such condition, and hereby waives any and all claims of damage resulting from such accidental injury or death.
7. The "breeder's certificate" / "registration application" will be issued to the MARE OWNER after processing of the "stallion breeding report" by the ApHC and only if all breeding fees and related expense have been paid in full. The MARE OWNER acknowledges that in order for the resulting foal to be registered with the ApHC, the mare must be registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club or one of the following ApHC approved breed associations:
 - American Quarter Horse Association, Amarillo, TX
 - Arabian Horse Registry of America, Denver, CO
 - The Jockey Club (Thoroughbred), New York, NY

A current copy of the mares registration papers (front and back) must accompany this contract.

Note:

If on-site breeding is to include over-night (or longer) mare care, the mare owner shall be responsible for contacting Moore Equine to determine costs and make arrangements for such. Costs for mare care are in addition to all other fees listed here-in.
